

# Virtual Meeting FAQs

## **Will there be a physical meeting location?**

No, our 70th Annual Meeting will be held virtually using CU Ballot Meeting Space and there will not be a physical meeting location.

## **What is CU Ballot?**

CU Ballot is a video meeting platform that allows individuals to connect in a virtual space using audio and video capabilities.

## **Do I need to register or sign up to attend the Annual Meeting?**

No: however, your account number is required to log on. If you do not know your account number do not hesitate to contact us at 308.345.7040 and we will gladly assist you with obtaining it.

## **What if more than one person in my household is a member of the credit union?**

If more than one member in the household will be attending the Annual Meeting, please have each member logon individually. This will allow us to enter all eligible primary members for prize drawings.

## **Will I have to purchase or download anything?**

There is no software purchase necessary to participate in the Annual Meeting and you do not need to create any account to participate in the Annual Meeting.

Whether you choose to attend the Annual Meeting by computer, tablet, or mobile device you will be asked for additional information in order to join the Annual Meeting.

## **When should I 'arrive' for the Annual Meeting?**

Please join at least 5 minutes early to ensure volume and internet connection are clear.

## **How do I participate in the Annual Meeting?**

After you have successfully logged on to the Annual Meeting you can submit a comment or question using the comment section on the right-hand side of your screen. Throughout the meeting you will also be promoted to vote on various motions.

## **Do I have to use a computer to participate in the Annual Meeting?**

You do not have to use a computer to participate in the Annual Meeting. You may join the meeting using a PC, Mac, iPad, iPhone, and Android devices.

## **Will we be voting on the nominations to the Board of Directors?**

Yes, members will have the opportunity to vote on the nominations to the Board of Directors during the Annual Meeting. More information on how voting will take place will be provided during the Annual Meeting.

## **Where can I find the Annual Report?**

All Annual Meeting documents, including the 2019 Annual Report, Minutes of the 69<sup>th</sup> Annual Meeting, and the presentation slides can be found in the 'Annual Meeting Documents'.

## **Will there be giveaways during the Annual Meeting?**
